

Indigenous Medicine Woman Retreat Scholarship

Greetings Beloved!

We are thrilled to unveil the 2024 Scholarship opportunities for the Indigenous Medicine Woman Retreat (formerly Indigenous Womb Healing, Herbalism & Ceremony Retreat)! Our Scholarship Program aims to grant access to transformative healing, education, and training to individuals keen on deepening their spiritual journey through the exploration of Indigenous Caribbean & Mayan Healing Modalities. Thanks to the generosity of our Sponsors, we're delighted to offer these scholarships for the 2024 retreat!

When applying, please consider the following:

- * Scholarship recipients must undergo our standard application process for retreat acceptance. (Read brochure, pay \$50 application fee, be interviewed by STH Medicine Woman Ambassador)
- * Retreat dates and scholarships are subject to availability.
- * Airfare is not covered by the scholarship.
- * Scholarship awards range from 25% to 100% of program costs.

To be considered for this Scholarship:

Step 1: Scholarship applicants must review our complimentary brochure and complete the standard application process.

Step 2: Send us a 60 second video detailing your desire to attend. Submissions can be shared via Google Drive to thesoultribegroup@gmail.com.

Once awarded:

* Attendance of all pre-retreat meetings, including orientation MANDATORY. Meetings commence on Tuesday, September 3rd-24th EST via Zoom, lasting approximately 1 to 1.5 hours. Topics typically covered include retreat expectations, spiritual hygiene, preparation for plant medicine ceremonies and more.

* Missed or late payments on a payment plan will result in forfeiture of the scholarship - No EXCEPTIONS! The cost to attend the retreat will default to \$4000.00 and must be paid in for 45 days before the start of the Retreat.

Payments are considered late after 24 hours. There are no refunds, and the scholarship is not transferable to subsequent retreats.

* All retreat payments are due 45 days before the retreat begins - NO EXCEPTIONS.

Energetic Exchange for the Scholarship:

* Willingness and ability to travel to Mexico and participate for the entire duration of the retreat. Full and active participation in all sessions, events, excursions and ceremonies is required.

* Offer a service for 2 days during the retreat, such as massage, reiki, sound bowl healing, yoga, dance, or breathwork. You will be responsible for all necessary supplies for your "medicine give back".

* Provide 2 testimonial videos (minimum 60 seconds each) by the last day of the retreat, detailing your personal healing experience and learning journey.

* Create and post 3 IG reels under 60 seconds for social media use within 1 week of returning, which can be shared via Google Drive to thesoultribegroup@gmail.com

* Provide assistance with sacred space tasks, such as sweeping, wiping down tables, washing dishes, and class setup.

If you possess additional skills beneficial to our community, such as photography, videography, or marketing, please include this information in your email as a separate paragraph or video. We aim to spread the word about our program to as many people as possible, enabling us to sponsor more individuals like yourself!

Timelines:

Nov 2024 Retreat: The deadline to submit your application and video is May 20th, 2024. Awardees will be notified via email on or before May 27th, 2024.

April 2025 Retreat: The deadline to submit your application and video is August 31, 2024. Awardees will be notified via email on or before September 7, 2024.

Please Note: There is a \$500 increase in price for the 2024 Retreat as we will be implementing a mandatory 12 week Indigenous Woman Rites of Passage Program.

Participants may take the Rite of Passage Program alone or couple it with the Retreat. There is no Scholarship for the Rites of Passage Program. The Rites of Passage Program alone is \$999 for the 12 week program.
